BCB's Mask Policy for June

Even though the mask mandate has been lifted for those who are vaccinated, BCB is requesting that all visitors to our office wear a face covering until they are seated for a meeting or appointment – at least for the month of June. This is for all clients, visitors, guests, members, staff, etc.

We will NOT require proof of having a COVID-19 vaccine, but if a person chooses to attend our activities, we ask that you continue to follow the CDC guidelines and wear a face covering until two weeks following your last vaccine.

BCB will request that volunteers wear a face covering when assisting clients or participants and serving boxed lunches, food or drinks. For the month of June, please be sure to bring a mask or cloth face covering for this reason. We hope to keep everyone as safe as possible and we hope this will be temporary. Thank you for your understanding and compliance with our decisions.

Vaccines Recommended but NOT Required to Participate in BCB Activities

As BCB slowly and carefully returns to in-person meetings, we want to clarify that we are NOT requiring participants to have the COVID-19

vaccine. We understand there are many reasons that some individuals are unable or choose not to be vaccinated, and we will not restrict them from participating or receiving services. There are many health conditions that prevent individuals from being vaccinated and we want to be sure we do not leave anyone out. Since we will not require proof of vaccination, please know if you do attend a group meeting, there MAY be others in attendance who are not vaccinated. We care about your safety and we are encouraging all who are able to be vaccinated to consider it for their safety and the safety of others. New Listening Device Making Its Debut at June Membership Meeting!

We will have 30 assistive listening devices available for use at the June Membership Meeting. These devices use ear phones or ear buds to connect to a small receiver so you can hear what the speaker is saying during the meeting.

They have headphones with them, but you are welcome and encouraged to bring your own ear buds or headphones with an 1/8-inch plug.

BCB and Partners to Offer O&M Clinic

BCB has recently partnered with the University of Kentucky Teachers of the Visually Impaired Program, KY Division of Blind Services (OVR) and the Kentucky School for the Blind (KSB) to produce an Orientation and Mobility (O&M) Clinic to fill the largest identified gap in services in Kentucky for people with vision impairments. The clinic will offer a variety of workshops in Lexington and across the state for individuals of all levels of interest and skills in orientation and mobility. Specific to blindness and low vision, O&M teaches safe, efficient and effective movement and travel skills to people of all ages. "Orientation" refers to the ability to know where you are and where

you want to go. Whether you're moving from one room to another or walking downtown to shop. "Mobility" refers to the ability to move safely, efficiently, and effectively from one place to another, such as being able to walk without tripping or falling, cross streets, and use public transportation. These skills are extremely important in allowing people who are visually impaired to continue living safely and independently, and Kentucky is short on O&M specialists AND available workshops for people with low to no vision. This clinic will offer a variety of workshops in Lexington and across the state for individuals of all levels of interest and skills in orientation and mobility. Workshops offer opportunities for people with visual impairments to learn much-needed skills while providing training for future O&M specialists. Each workshop will have multiple sessions and each session is optional. The first workshop will include the topics of guide dog teams and using a GPS device when navigating. That workshop will be on Saturday, July 31, from 9 AM to 3 PM on the University of Kentucky campus.

The informative Q&A session will be held at the BCB office on Thursday, July 8th, from 7 PM to 8 PM and will be made accessible by Zoom for those who cannot attend in person.
