Orientation & Mobility Clinic Opens in July; Informational Meeting July 8

BCB has partnered with the University of Kentucky Teachers of the Visually Impaired Program, KY Division of Blind Services (OVR) and the Kentucky School for the Blind (KSB) to produce an Orientation and Mobility (O&M) Clinic, filling the largest identified gap in services in Kentucky for people with vision impairments. The clinic will offer a variety of workshops in Lexington and across the state for individuals of all levels of interest and skills in orientation and mobility. Specific to blindness and low vision, O&M teaches safe, efficient and effective movement and travel skills to people of all ages. "Orientation" refers to the ability to know where you are and where you want to go, whether you're moving from one room to another or walking downtown to shop. "Mobility" refers to the ability to move safely, efficiently, and effectively from one place to another, such as being able to walk without tripping or falling, cross streets, and use public transportation. These skills are extremely important in allowing people who are visually impaired to continue living safely and independently, and Kentucky is short on O&M specialists *and* available workshops for people with low to no vision.

Workshops offer opportunities for people with visual impairments to learn much-needed skills while providing training for future O&M specialists. Each workshop will have multiple sessions and each session is optional. Each month, we distribute a variety of grocery items to people who are blind or visually impaired and in need of food due to financial difficulties or barriers to shopping. During the pandemic, we started delivering those items to people's homes. Now that we are meeting in person again, we will distribute those food items to people who attend Lunch & Learn meetings in person and deliver the items the following day to those who cannot attend and live in Fayette County. (Those who wish to participate in the food distribution and attend the Lunch & Learn meetings in person will be expected to take their food home with them.) For those attending the July Lunch & Learn, food distribution will be at 2 PM, immediately following the meeting.
