## Free O&M Workshop in Lexington March 26

Part of the ongoing Orientation & Mobility Clinic produced by the Bluegrass Council of the Blind, University of Kentucky's Orientation and Mobility graduate program, Kentucky School for the Blind, and the Kentucky Division of Blind Services, an O&M workshop for individuals who have a vision impairment and wish to improve their confidence and safety in traveling around their home, school, work and community will be held on Saturday, March 26, 2022, at UK in Lexington. All ages and skill levels are invited. You are welcome whether you've already received some training or if it will be your first experience.

This free workshop will focus on using a white cane and the skills and issues related to safely travel in the community. The two- to three-hour workshop will include both group and individualized instruction provided by University of Kentucky's Orientation and Mobility program, including UK professors who are certified Orientation and Mobility Specialists as well as graduate students in this specialized program.

Each participant will receive a brief assessment to identify their personal travel goals and needs, and to determine their current skill levels. Topics covered in this workshop will include the following indoor and outdoor skills and techniques:

- · Human guide instruction, including use of stairs and doorways
- Protective techniques, and trailing
- Search patterns and locating dropped objects
- Familiarization to new environments
- Problem solving techniques
- Introduction to use of the cane
- Cane techniques including locating and traveling on steps and dropoffs
- · Requesting or refusing assistance
- Sidewalk and outdoor route travel
- Use of visual skills during travel
- Intersection awareness

The morning session is 9 AM – noon Afternoon session is 1 – 4 PM.

If you are blind or visually impaired and in need of food due to financial difficulties or barriers to shopping, BCB can help. We offer a predetermined variety of grocery items each month that you can pick up at our monthly Lunch & Learn meetings, which occur on the fourth Wednesday of each month. If you cannot attend the Lunch & Learn meetings and live in Fayette County, we can deliver your items to your home the day after the monthly Lunch & Learn. Any person attending the Lunch & Learn meetings on the 4th Wednesday of each month and who is visually impaired is eligible to participate in the food distribution, regardless of what county they reside in. Distribution is subject to availability.

**Registration:** To register for food delivery, call 859-259-1834 and press 1 to leave your name, street address and phone number, and state that you would like food delivered. If you are unsure of your availability, please only

call when you are certain of your arrangements to avoid confusion. If you have questions, please call the BCB office during normal office hours and press zero to talk with a staff member.
