People with Low or No Vision Can Receive 12 Accessible COVID-19 Tests

In a previous BCB Bulletin, we reported that the federal government had a new initiative to expand the availability of COVID-19 testing options that are more accessible for people who are blind or have low vision and who use a smartphone. On July 7, the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services announced the number of tests people will receive with each order of the more accessible tests has been increased from two to 12. They will ship in six separate packages of two, each with its own tracking number. To receive the more accessible COVID-19 at-home tests, click here to order online or call 1-800-232-0233.
