You're Invited to the 2022 Helen Keller Symposium: Hidden Legacies of Helen Keller

Date/Time: Saturday, Sept. 17, from 8 AM to 7 PM and Sunday, Sept. 18, from 10 AM to 4 PM

Where: The Filson Historical Society at 1310 South 3rd in Louisville Everyone thinks they know Helen Keller's story. But Keller – an author, activist, fundraiser, advocate, sister, daughter, ambassador, friend, celebrity, and champion of women, people with disabilities and those living in poverty around the globe – defies easy description. This two-day symposium

explores, from dynamic and diverse perspectives across the spectrum of disability history scholarship and experiences, the hidden historical legacy and context of this great American. The talks will be accompanied by highlights from the rich archives of the American Foundation for the Blind (AFB), Keller's employer for 40 years. The AFB collections are now located in the Museum of the American Printing House for the Blind (APH) in Louisville. On Sunday, September 18, there is an additional opportunity, a behind-the-scenes tour of the AFB Helen Keller Archive at the Printing House.

Tickets are \$75 standard admission; \$25 Student Admission; Free to APH Staff and Free to Members of the Filson Historical Society.
