Topic: More than Statistics: Warning Signs and Steps to take for Preventing Suicide.

In addition to recent statistics on the prevalence of suicide, Larry will present on warning signs, risk factors, resources and steps to help someone that may be suicidal. In 2019 and 2020, we saw documented suicide numbers decrease for the first time in fifteen years but in 2021

(most current data) we saw almost a four percent increase from 2020, with teens and young adults being the hardest hit group for mental health disorders since the pandemic.
