Hart-Supported Living Program Helps Those with Disabilities Remain at Home

The Hart-Supported Living program provides funds for supports to help Kentuckians with disabilities live in their homes and communities and avoid institutionalization.

The statute enabling the state Hart-Supported Living Program, <u>KRS 210.770</u>, provides that the program makes grants for a broad category of flexible, individualized services that, when combined with natural unpaid or other eligible paid supports:

- Help a disabled person live in a home of the person's choice, typical of living arrangements for persons without disabilities;
- Encourage participation in the community with persons among the general population;
- Promote rights and autonomy;
- Enhance skills and abilities to live successfully in the community; and
- Enable acceptance in the community by promoting home ownership or leasing arrangements.
