Speaker and Program: We will have Sarah Richardson in person as our guest speaker. Sarah is an Administrator with the Vocational Rehabilitation office and will talk to us about the STABLE program, which has launched in Kentucky to make savings more accessible for everyone! This program allows qualified individuals with disabilities to save up to \$18,000 a year in an ABLE account without jeopardizing their eligibility for federally funded means-tested benefits, such as Supplemental Security Income (SSI) and Medicaid. The funds in the account can be used for disability-related expenses that assist in increasing and/or maintaining health, independence or quality of life. These accounts are exciting for families and individuals who want to work and earn money to improve their lives but who also rely

on government programs for health insurance or supplemental income. This important development is key in constructing a new framework of financial independence for people with disabilities. Kentucky Revised Statutes § 205.200 establishes the rules for STABLE Kentucky, and the Office of Kentucky State Treasurer manages this program.
